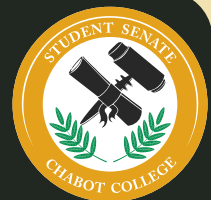

William H. Hopper Scholarships - \$1,000

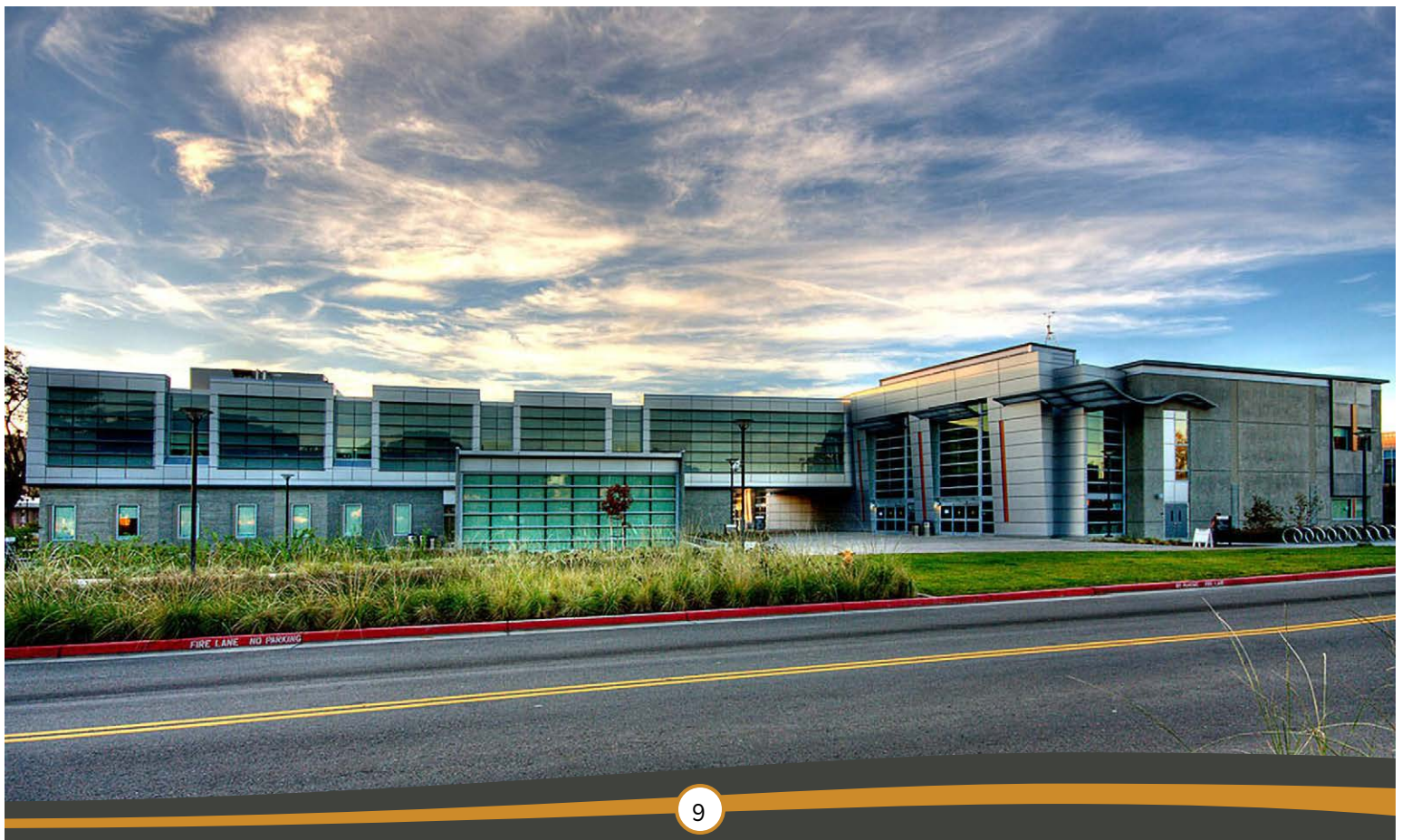
